The Pyrzynski family, Geoffrey, Stephanie and Eileah, have called Tinley Park's Cambridge Place their home for more than six years. According to Stephanie, the location is ideal for them because they have family very close by and they are close to Tinley's outstanding schools.

"My husband grew up in Tinley for almost his whole life, so it just made sense (to settle in Tinley)," says Stephanie. "It's where he started our business, Geoffresh, back in 2007, so it just felt right to make this our family's home too."

Stephanie and Geoffrey initially met in February of 2008. Stephanie explains she really liked him as a person after the brief encounter and was glad a mutual friend linked their paths once again in 2010. They were married May 19, 2014 on the ship Disney Fantasy, somewhere in the Eastern Caribbean.

Geoffrey and Stephanie both graduated from University of Illinois Chicago (UIC) in 2011. Geoffrey has a Bachelor of Science degree in Entrepreneurship and Stephanie has a Bachelor of Applied Psychology degree and a master's in Communication from Loyola University Chicago. An avid reader who enjoys writing, music, movies, and watching TV, Stephanie shares a very interesting story about her heritage. "I'm Serbian and am actually the first citizen born abroad in what was called the former Yugoslavia. A photo of me appeared in one of the country's newspapers. I was born in the town Kragujevac."

Stephanie says the family has many fun spots they enjoy throughout the region. She says Eileah goes to Gymboree in Orland Hills, Sky Zone in Orland Park, and the Tinley Park Public Library, where her paternal grandmother (Mary Ann) is the Circulation Desk Manager.

"In the summer we explore as many Illinois forest preserves, museums, and other outdoor places as possible," says Stephanie. "I love how we can jump north to visit my parents, and south, east, and west so quickly thanks to having quick access to I-80 and La Grange Road. There's so much to explore in Chicago's south suburbs and beyond."

Speaking of exploring, the Pyrzynski family does have a fourth member: Samantha (Sammie), a 5-year-old Pointer-Jack



Russell mix, who gave the family quite a scare a few years ago when they were involved in a car accident and she leapt out a side window and took off.

"We live in a townhome that looks like every other townhome in our subdivision, so she couldn't find our home. But she remembered her best dog friend Maddie's house, my parents-inlaws' home," says Stephanie. "Their security camera showed that she crawled under a wire fence, she had bloody scratches on her belly from that, and arrived in their backyard at 12:45 in the morning. She'd been missing for twelve hours."

Stephanie says she almost cried when she learned that Sammie, rather than barking and alerting everyone in the home she was outside, slept on the steps to their backdoor all night. "She's so sweet and considerate like that, I think she didn't want to wake anyone. When my father-in-law Ron saw her (the next morning) he called us right away. He thought he was imagining her. It was a wonderful surprise," she says. During their free time, Stephanie says the Pyrzynski family has many local favorites including Frankie's Ristorante and Tokyo Steakhouse, which at press time was closed by COVID-19 restrictions and she was fearful of their re-opening. Some activities they enjoy together are bike riding, drawing with chalk outside, and kite flying.

"I'm a 1990s Chicago Bulls fan, but I got back into Chicago sports when I became a Blackhawks fan when I began dating my husband," she says. "I've also always liked watching tennis matches since I was little."

Stephanie, who is a member of the Tinley Park Chamber of Commerce and on its Marketing Committee, as well as a commissioner on the Tinley Park Branding and Marketing Committee since 2018, says they enjoy Tinley Park events and they especially enjoy the parades. Although, she admits, playing with Eileah and being involved with teaching her things is the great pleasure of each day.

One of the other great pleasures for Stephanie has been the opportunity to work with Geoffrey every day in the family business. Geoffresh (pronounced jef-fresh) specializes in SEO web design, affordable internet marketing, and internet marketing consulting on social media, brand strategy and tech support for small and large businesses.

While attending the couple's alma mater, the University of Illinois at Chicago, Geoffrey started Geoffresh in 2007. Stephanie, who joined as a vice president in 2012, explains he was the guy who would help neighbors, friends, and whoever needed help with technology problems.



Summer is here and the smells from backyard BBQs and grill outs are wafting through the neighbourhood. Before firing up your grill this season, remember to be safe. The National Fire Protection Agency reports that nearly 8,500 fires involving grills occur each year. These fires resulted in an annual average of 10 civilian deaths, 140 civilian injuries and \$75 million in direct property damage.

Following these eight, simple, safety tips will help make your grilling experience a safer one:

- 1 Only use propane and charcoal BBQ grills outdoors.
- 2 The grill should be placed well away from the home, deck railings and out from under eaves and overhanging branches. Grilling on outdoor balconies in many communities is against fire code and illegal.
- 3 Always keep children and pets at least three feet away from the grill area.
- 4 Keep your grill clean by removing grease or fat buildup from the grill and in the trays below the grill.
- 5 NEVER leave the grill unattended when in use.

- 6 Always make sure your gas grill lid is open before lighting it if you're using gas, and never add charcoal, starter fluid or any other flammable liquid to a fire already going in a grill.
- 7 If you are using a charcoal grill, always allow the coals to cool before disposing of them. Always dispose of them in a METAL container.
- 8 If you are using a gas grill, inspect the tank and hose for leaks before using it.

Understand Property Values, Taxes During Pandemic

Vour home is the backbone of your investment portfolio and your family's safe zone. Now, more than ever, it's critically important to protect your family from excessive property taxes.

Nobody likes to pay property taxes. Understandably, we only want to pay our fair share. Unfortunately, 7 out of 10 families actually overpay! Based upon a three-year re-assessment cycle, we are told what portion of the government's taxation (levy) revenue pie we are required to pay. In Illinois, we are provided the "opportunity" to appeal on an annual basis with our township or county assessor's office.

By successfully lowering your assessment, your twice-annual bill will go down the following three years. The taxing bodies still get their required (levied) amount they requested, but other property owners shares will go up. In essence, the squeaky wheel gets the oil in this informal, poor man's court process. Most of the south suburbs and Will County open up for appeals June through August. Tinley Park residents should act now.

Pandemic Impact

There has been a drastic change as a result of the COVID-19 outbreak. Normally, the Cook County Assessor's office is responsible for re-assessing one third of the county's properties each year. Their office opens up each of the 36-plus townships for 40-day windows, where property owners can submit evidence disputing their new assessments. Will County taxpayers will submit their appeals in August.

When the pandemic hit, the assessor's office closed. In order to catch-up, they have announced all remaining assessments will be performed simultaneously placing further strain on everyone. The burden on the homeowners is even greater - they must submit concise and effective evidence. A qualified tax consultant can help greatly streamline this process and likely increase the chance for a property tax reduction.

The good news is that this year's bill in Cook County, typically due in August, has been granted a grace period for payment until the end of October. Will County taxpayers can break their May and August payments into four installments. All of these extensions come with no interest or penalties. Call it a pandemic prayer!


